



Unilever Federal Credit Union Scholarship Application 2022

The Award

The Unilever Federal Credit Union scholarship is an award of up to \$2,000 to be paid to winning students.

Eligibility

The applicant must be a member in good standing of the Unilever Federal Credit Union and must be enrolled as a high school senior at the time of the application.

Scholarship funds must be used for tuition only at an accredited educational institution (community college, 4-year college, university, or technical/vocational school).

Application Process

Eligible members must complete this scholarship application in its entirety and return it to the credit union by the **April 1, 2022 deadline**. The application must be completed and signed by the student and parent/guardian.

The signed and completed application must be submitted with the following:

- ☐ An official high school transcript that includes a **cumulative GPA** of completed marking periods as of date of submission. GPA must be **NON-WEIGHTED** on a **4.0 scale**.
- ☐ The completed Teacher Reference portion of the application (see page 4). It must be completed and signed by one of the applicant's teachers.

The application (page 2 and 3 of this form), transcript, and Teacher Reference (page 4) must be returned to the credit union by the application deadline: **April 1, 2022.** If any portion of the application is incomplete or not included, the applicant will be disqualified.

Selection Process

Judging is based on academic performance, extracurricular activities, community service/involvement, references, and leadership roles.
